Brief Note - Summer Camps for Children under our Mental Health – Jagruti – II Project.

The Development Support Team (DST) Organization conducted a 3-day Summer Camp for children aged 8 to 14 years in the Old Sangavi, PCMC area from 13th to 15th May 2026. A total of 65 children attended and participated actively.

The camp was organised as part of DST's ongoing mental Health Jagruti – II project.

Resource persons from diverse fields of child development and Literature were invited to provide specific inputs during the camp. Ms. Unnati Gokhale conducted an Origami session, where children learned paper-folding art especially creating pictures of animals through this exercise. Ms. Rashmi Ghatge provided inputs on basic yoga practices for children. Mr. Eknath Aavhad conducted a beautiful storytelling session that participating children enjoyed a lot. The RESQ organization gave an interesting presentation on wildlife and animal healthcare. Ms. Aabha Bhagwat conducted a creative drawing session for the children, where children could learn many artistic ways to do drawings. The DST team conducted a story writing activity based on picture on the board, where children imagined and wrote their own stories. They shared many creative and interesting stories during the session.

The camp was a fun and meaningful learning experience for the children of the Sangvi Community. They enjoyed learning new things through different activities and took active part in all sessions. Children also asked many interesting questions and enthusiastically shared jokes and puzzles during the camp. It was a wonderful combination of fun and learning.
